The Site

The site is 6.26 Ha in size and is defined by open fields and farmland along its southern boundary; industrial green houses with a mix of temporary accommodation, residential and business uses on the eastern boundary; Castle Street adjoining the site's northern boundary; and the B3092 (Mapperton Hill) adjoining the sites western boundary. The edges of the site are clearly defined by a number of well-established hedgerows, field boundaries and fences.

The site is within walking distance of a number of local facilities and amenities including public transport links.

The Proposal

The proposals envisage the construction of a new residential development of up to 130 dwellings of varying size with associated landscape and access works. In addition to new high quality family homes, proposals also include new affordable dwellings, public open space, sustainable urban drainage systems and ponds, and a significant level of new planting.
